MISSION STATEMENT

To provide financial resources for student scholarships and educational development for Life Christian Academy. To provide financial resources for sustaining special ministries and programs for Life Center.

VISION STATEMENT

Every student has the financial support to continue their education at Life Christian Academy. Life Christian Academy has the resources to enhance its delivery of high-quality education. Life Center program priorities are funded for their sustained impact.

LIFE CHRISTIAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Partial tuition scholarships shall be granted to selected students who meet the eligibility criteria and demonstrate the following characteristics as determined by the Foundation, in its sole discretion, including:

- 1. Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student at LCA at the time of application and must meet the scholarship criteria.
- 2. Character, behavior and achievement must exemplify the ideals of Life Christian Academy's Mission Statement and Core Values.
- 3. The Lordship of Jesus Christ must be evident in the student's character, behavior and achievement.
- 4. For needs-based scholarships, preference will be given to students who are receiving Tuition Assistance (TA) this year, but they must also receive TA next year (application to be made via the Life Christian Academy process), GPA standards must be met, and the student must be in a good behavioral standing with the school.
- 5. The children of LCA faculty are eligible for merit-based scholarships only.
- 6. International students may only apply for the International Student Scholarship. International students are ineligible for other Life Christian Foundation Scholarship due to the nature of their tenure and agreement to attend LCA which is consistent with the original intent of the donors who established the endowments that fund the scholarships. An international student is defined as a student who falls under the international student program where an international student visa is needed to attend LCA.
- 7. All scholarship recipients are expected to finish the academic year to receive the full value of the scholarship.
- 8. Only Grade 12 students are eligible for College scholarships.

NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

Student must apply for and receive tuition assistance.

WALLACE HANSEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 11 or 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.5 or higher with high scores in mathematics and science courses taken in their previous years of school.
- 3. Student must have a strong interest in mathematics and science and participate in a course selection load that reflects that strong interest.

LIFE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 11 or 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- 3. Evidence of involvement in extracurricular programs.
- 4. Student must participate in LCA leadership and ministry programs.

KEN & IRENE HULTGREN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 9 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- 3. Evidence of spiritual and academic growth is necessary for consideration of renewal of this scholarship.

MICHAEL & KRISTINA PUTNAM SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 9 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 3. Students must participate in a LCA extracurricular activity such as Athletics, Knowledge Bowl, ASB, SLi, Fine Arts, National Honor Society, Interact, etc.
- 4. Scholarship will be available to the same student each year until graduation, providing criteria is met.

WILLIAM & LILLIAN BOND MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 7 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success within the LIFE Program.

SCHULER FAMILY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 6 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- 3. Scholarship will be available to the same student each year until graduation, providing criteria is met.

BOHRMAN-FJERMEDAL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 6 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student attitude and behavior would be beyond reproach.
- 3. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

PAUL & LOIS PUTNAM SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 6 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 3. Student may be enrolled in the LIFE program.
- 4. Scholarship will be available to the same student each year until graduation, providing criteria is met.

MATTHEW METCALF MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 6 through 12 in the next academic year.

- 3. Full-time student in good standing at LCA.
- 4. Student must be enrolled at LCA a minimum of two years prior to be considered for this scholarship.
- 5. Scholarship will be available to the same student each year until graduation, providing criteria is met.

WILLIAMSON FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 9 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student efforts should show significant potential and promise as a person.
- 3. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 4. Student must participate in extracurricular activity(s).
- 5. Scholarship will be available to the same student each year until graduation, providing criteria is met.

WOOMER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 9 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must be enrolled at LCA a minimum of two years prior to be considered for this scholarship.
- 3. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 4. Students must participate in a LCA extracurricular activity such as Athletics, Knowledge Bowl, ASB, SLi, Fine Arts, National Honor Society, Interact, etc.

- 2. Student must show a record of volunteerism.
- 3. Student must show a need for the financial scholarship.
- 4. Student must show that empathy is a common characteristic in their life.

RIDER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 7 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3. Student should be raised by a single parent or by the grandparent(s).
- 4. Scholarship will be available to the same student each year until graduation, providing criteria is met.

MCREYNOLDS FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Character and achievement exemplify the ideals of LCA mission statement.
- 2. Evidence of academic success at a GPA of 3.0 or better within a challenging course selection process.
- 3. Student should be enrolled in grade 7 through 12.
- 4. Student must qualify for tuition assistance based upon the LCA system.

CHRISTOPHER MORSE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Character and achievement testify to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- 2. Student enrolls in LIFE program classes to maintain graduation status.
- 3. Students should be enrolled in grades 7 through 12.
- 4. Preference given to a student from a single parent household.
- 5. Student must qualify for tuition assistance based upon the LCA system.

- 4. Student's character and achievement should testify to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

MCGEE FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 8 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.0 or higher within a challenge course selection.
- 3. Student must have a strong interest in extracurricular programs and participate in school activities that reflect this interest.
- 4. Scholarship will be available to the same student each year until graduation, providing criteria is met.

LEE FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 6 through 12 in the next academic year who exemplify a strong interest in music.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 3. Have musical or Fine Arts talent. which may include vocal or instrumental music, drama, dance or arts.
- 4. Make Life Center your weekend worship center during your scholarship year and participate in Life Center Fine Arts.

FENTON FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to female students entering Grade 9 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of significant academic improvement during the past year.
- 3. Scholarship will be available to the same student each year until graduation, providing criteria is met.

- 4. Student must show consistent best effort and exemplary achievement in academics.
- 5. Student must participate in school sponsored programs each year.

- 4. Scholarship(s) will be used as a credit towards the cost of an LCA sponsored mission trip.

- 1. Open to students enrolled in Grade 12 and accepted to a university.
- 2. Character and achievement exemplify the ideals of Life Christian Academy's mission statement.
- 3. Character and achievement testify to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- 4. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- 5. Student must exhibit exemplary leadership qualities throughout their school experience at LCA.
- 6. Students who have participated in Student Leadership Institute will be given strongest consideration.

TAYLOR FERRIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Open to students entering Grade 8 through 12 in the next academic year.
- 2. Student must show evidence of academic success by achieving a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

- 4. Scholarship will be available to the same student each year until graduation, providing criteria is met.
